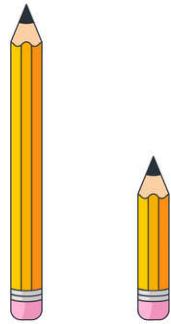


Oak Green School Curriculum Newsletter

This Spring term, during our Ready Steady Grow topic, the children have enjoyed learning all about farms and vocabulary about the machinery used on farms. The children also created repeating patterns through fruit printing and thoroughly enjoyed learning about healthy food and the importance of eating fruit during our Eat a Rainbow lesson.

This half term in maths, we have been exploring the numbers 6, 7 and 8 in a variety of ways, using a range of manipulatives to deepen understanding. We have also been investigating length by identifying and comparing objects around the classroom, and sorting them according to whether they are 'long' or 'short'. In addition, we have been developing our understanding of the concepts of 'one more' and 'one less'. Reception children have also shown great effort in developing their number formation, practising writing numbers 1-10 with increasing pencil control.

This half term in Independent Writing, we were practicing writing based on the very exciting topics e.g. Travel, Food, Superheroes and Signs of spring. Every Monday we arranged a classroom in a very stimulating way, for children to talk about it and then put their ideas into the writing. Reception children produced some fantastic work, with much stronger pencil control and an accurate letter formation. We can proudly say that we have many talented writers.
