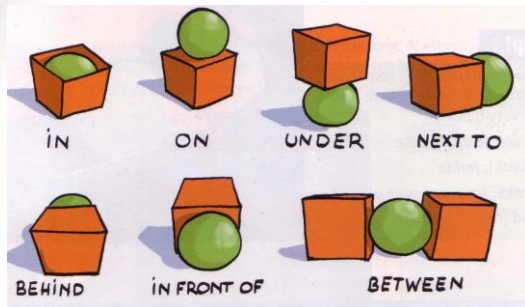

Cornerstones

This term, the children have been learning about machines, exploring how they have changed from the past to the present. As part of our investigations, we carried out an experiment to compare the speed of handmade and machine-made objects. The children thoroughly enjoyed designing and building their own cars using toilet rolls, wooden wheels, and axles and discovering what makes a car move. They also began drawing machines and labelling three key features.
