Welcome back to school for the final term of the academic year! We are looking forward to lots of fun events and learning to complete what has been a fantastic year so far.

Learning planned for this term

We have lots of exciting learning this term. We will be focusing on history, art and D&T. In history, we are learning all about the Roman Empire. In art, we will be making some amazing mosaics! In D&T, we will be exploring how to make mini greenhouses.

In English, we will focus mystery narratives about Egypt and pyramids. Our book for this term is 'Egyptology'. In grammar, we will focus on words families, using speech and a variety of prepositions.

In maths we will be learning about adding and subtracting fractions and money. We will also be learning about time and solving word problems. In the second half of term we will be learning about shapes and their angles. The children will also continue practising their times tables to 12x12. Please practise these at home as much as you can using times tables rock stars.

In science we will be learning about plants and investigating the functions of leaves, roots, stems and flowers. In the second half of term we will be learning about light and conducting lots of practical experiments. We are very excited about our very special visit from Lovely Light for a day of hands on learning.

In RE, the children will learn how Sanatanis and Humanists lead good lives and learn about their values and beliefs. In PSHE, our unit will be 'Relationships' and we will be looking at how we can be good friends to others, resolve conflict healthily and explore family roles and responsibilities. We will continue our Spanish learning by learning how to talk about different seasons, and we will be learning how to talk about Ancient Britain in Spanish too, to link in with our topic learning.
