Happy New Year and welcome back to another new term! We are looking forward to another busy term with lots of exciting events and learning planned.

Learning planned for this term

We have lots of exciting topics this term. Our geography topic for the whole of the term is 'Rocks, Relics and Rumbles'. This project teaches children about the characteristics and features of Earth's layers, including a detailed exploration of volcanic, tectonic and seismic activity.

In English, we will be doing some fantastic narrative writing; our vehicle text is 'The Rhythm of the Rain' and the children will be creating their own information leaflet. We will then be looking at 'A Midsummer Night's Dream' and learning how to write our own potion recipes!

In maths, we will be looking at multiplication, division, length and perimeter and fractions. Please continue to practice your times tables at home as much as you can using Times Tables Rockstars, we know that you have already been working hard on them.

Our science topics for the term are 'Rocks' where we will be learning how to compare and group different rocks. We will also be exploring 'Forces and magnets' where we will be looking at their effects on different everyday objects.

We will continue our Spanish learning this term by learning about animals.

In PSHE as part of our Jigsaw scheme, our unit will be 'Dreams and Goals' looking at what our goals are, how we can achieve them and how to be resilient when we don't always get the results we want.
