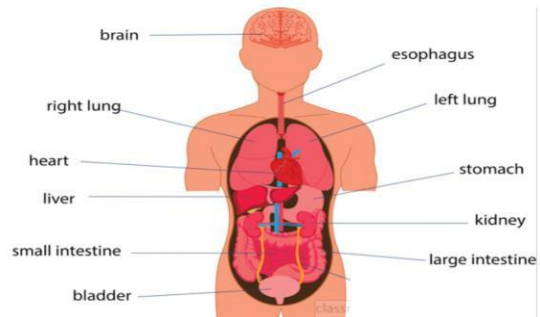


Oak Green School Curriculum Newsletter

In science, we explored the human body, focusing on understanding the circulatory system. We identified and named the main parts of the circulatory system, describing the functions of the heart, blood vessels, and blood. We examined the impact of diet, exercise, drugs, and lifestyle on how our bodies function. Additionally, we described how nutrients and water are transported within animals, including humans.



In art, the children explored the theme of *Trailblazers, Barrier Breakers*, a project connected to Maafa. Through this initiative, they learned about significant black artists and their impactful work. The children had opportunities to analyse these artists' creations and produce their own artwork inspired by them.

In geography, we focused on our changing world. We learned about time zones around the world, latitude and longitude, the features of Earth, climate change and global warming, extreme weather and its impact on people, human settlement patterns, and trade around the world. Additionally, we explored map scales, maps of different scales, traffic data, grid references, contour lines, and map symbols. As geographers, we developed our skills as map-readers and map-makers, learning how to interpret maps with accuracy.
