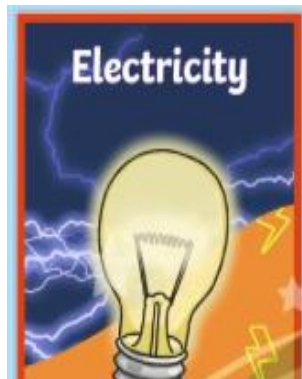
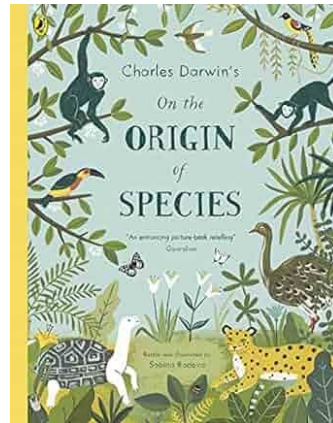


Oak Green School Curriculum Newsletter
Year 6
Summer 1, 2026

In English lessons this half term, Year 6 have been inspired to write discovery narratives based on Charles Darwin's book 'On the Origin of Species' adapted by Sabina Radeva. While composing their narrative writing, the children have considered their use of descriptive language for settings and character and using effective dialogue to move the action along.



In science this term, Year 6 have been learning about electricity through practical experiments. The children have explored how the brightness of a lamp and the volume of a buzzer is affected by the number of voltage of cells in a circuit. The children also investigated and explained variations on how different components function including change in bulb brightness, buzzer loudness and operation of switches.

In history, the children have been learning about World War I and will be moving onto World War II in Summer 2. They have learnt about the factors that led to the start of World War I and explored how it affected those on the front line and those on the home front by listening to podcasts and analysing a range of primary as well as secondary sources.
