Headline visit:

We recently had our yearly Headline Visit from the Local Authority following our successful Ofsted report last summer. Here is a very positive extract from the report:

"Following the learning walk, several strengths were evident across the school. Behaviour for learning was consistently strong, with pupils engaged, focused, and demonstrating positive attitudes to their learning. The learning environment across classrooms was purposeful and well organised, clearly supporting pupils' learning and reflecting a consistent approach throughout the school. There was a strong sense of pride in the school environment, which was evident in the presentation of classrooms and in the high standard of pupils' work in books."

MCAS App:

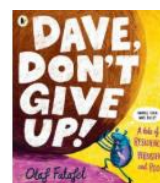

Author Visit:

This term, we have been fortunate to welcome two award-winning authors to our school. The wonderfully funny Olaf Falafel entertained the whole of KS1 with a lively read aloud of his latest book *Dave Don't Give Up!* all about Dave the Dung Beetle. Through this hilarious picture-book story, the children explored important themes of resilience and positive thinking. Olaf also demonstrated how he creates his characters by live sketching a character based on the children's suggestions, giving them a fascinating insight into the illustration process.

We also welcomed Clare Pollard to work with our KS2 pupils. Clare is an acclaimed author of books, poetry and plays. She shared extracts from her new book, *The Othernavts*, a fun and imaginative retelling of the Greek myths surrounding Jason and the Argonauts. Inspired by her work, the children drew upon their knowledge of Greek gods and goddesses to plan their own quest tales under Clare's expert guidance.
